SUNDAY GOSPEL READING

In illo tēpore assumpsit Jesus Petrum, et Jacóbum, et Joánnem fratrem ejus, et ducit illos in montem excelsum seorsum: et transfigurátus est ante eos. Et resplénduit fácies ejus sicut sol: vestiménta autem ejus facta sunt alba sicut nix. Et ecce apparuérunt illis Móyses et Elías cum eo loquéntes.

Respóndens autem Petrus, dixit ad Jesum: Dómine, bonum est nos hic esse: si vis, faciámus hic tria tabernacula, tibi unum, Móysi unum, et Elíæ unum. Adhuc eo loquénte, ecce nubes lúcida obumbrávit eos. Et ecce vox de nube, dicens: Hic est Fílius meus diléctus, in quo mihi bene complácu: ipsum audíte. Et audiéntes discípuli cecidérunt in fáciem suam, et timuérunt valde.

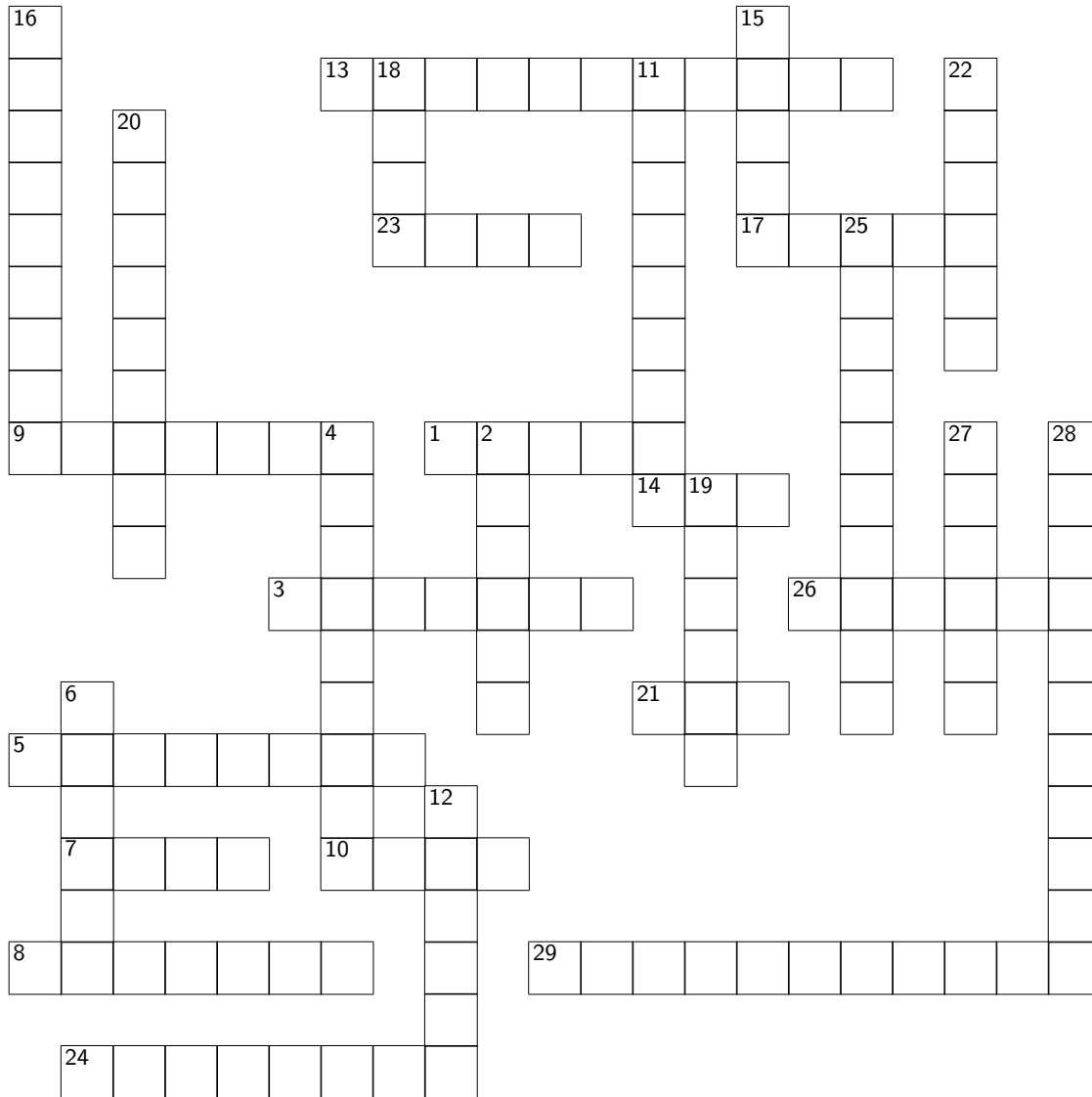
